Stewards

The Church Stewards are elected at the Annual Church Meeting and act as an executive body, implementing decisions of the Church Council.

The stewards meet regularly to assure the spiritual and material well-being of the church, and discuss worship, social events fellowship opportunities and outreach.

Church Council

The Church Council usually meets 3 times a year. All members of the church over 18 are eligible for election to the Church Council, and elected members serve for a maximum term of six years. The Council functions as the church's Managing Trustees under charity law, is the body that makes decisions, and therefore has major responsibility. Meetings are usually open to any member of the church and congregation who may wish to attend as an observer.
